The Adele DeLeeuw Scholarship is governed by the following restrictions:

1. The student must graduate from a **public, private or parochial high school in the Plainfield area, defined as the communities of Plainfield, North Plainfield, South Plainfield, Fanwood, Scotch Plains, Edison, Watchung, and Warren.**
 2. The student must be a **high school senior and accepted at an accredited college or university**, or be an Adele DeLeeuw scholarship recipient currently in college at the time of application. Previous Adele DeLeeuw scholarship winners may re-apply by submitting a new application. **All applicants must submit application with a complete, official transcript of grades.**
 3. The student **must principally engage in further education in one or more of the following areas of study: art, poetry, writing, journalism, and engineering.** The student must demonstrate the scholastic aptitude and interest to pursue such study.
 4. **The student must demonstrate financial need.**
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Application for consideration may be made only through completion of this Application for Adele DeLeeuw Scholarship which should be sent to the address below.

- Upon consideration of the application, the applicant may be requested to appear for an interview before the selection committee.
- The completion of an application and any subsequent interview does not automatically assure the applicant of success in achieving an award, which will be competitive in nature and within the limits of funds available in any calendar year.
- If awarded, funds will be paid by the Plainfield Foundation to the college or university for credit to the recipient's account, to be used during a specified academic period.
- Any award under this program will be made without discrimination toward race, sexual orientation, national origin, religion, or handicap.
